So basically with this interview we are trying to know from you :

Background of the ambassador

Here we are trying to just know you better and your journey with Fedora so far :)

1. What universities are you affiliated to? How involved are each of these universities?
2. How many events have you organized/ taken part till now?

-What kind?

-The number of attendees in these events?

3. What opportunities does the ambassador see for Fedora usage at the universities you are familiar with. (Like a university has classes that use Fedora in the classroom and they would like to organize support from ambassadors. Or students working on projects within Fedora for their classwork / research.)

1. How do you reach out to other potential fedora contributors that might be interested in helping you organize it?

Content for the Event

Okay now that we know about you better, let's start with organizing an event.

1. What factors do you take into account while deciding the
 - a) type of the event? Install fests, to barcamps / mini conferences, release parties, etc.
 - b) content for the event? Say, you may choose introduction to FOSS contribution for college undergraduates.
2. How do you prepare for the chosen topic (material provided by Fedora/ self /etc)?
3. What kind of events work better for engaging the audience?
4. What are the gaps that you feel should be filled in the content that is presented?

During the Event

Tell us about how the audience for an event is?

1. How do you manage to get attendees to install the necessary for the session : ask them to preinstall, help them install before/during the event, etc? What are the problems you face?
2. How long does it take for audiences to start asking questions/ get familiar with you?

3. What kind of questions are asked during/after the session? Do people hesitate asking their doubts in front of audience?
4. How do you pace the presentation to suit the speed of learning of the audience?
5. Do you have to supplement information in the presentation at times to answer their queries?
6. Do you feel enough support is available to answer their queries?
7. What has been the general reaction of the participants to the content presented? Are they satisfied with the learnings?

After the Event

How effective are we in creating an impact and getting potential contributors onboard?

1. How do you follow up with interested/potential contributors?
2. Do you provide them with links/resources to further explore? Do you feel the quality and quantity of resources is sufficient?
3. How often do potential contributors contact you after an event to learn more?

Organization of Event

Just a few more things that we would like to know from you :)

- Venue

1. Factors that you take into consideration while choosing a venue?
2. What are the problems you face?

- Number of attendees

1. How do you gather attendees for the event?
2. How do estimate the approximate attendance before the event?

- Setup at the venue

1. How do you arrange for the setup : projector, laptop?

- Publicity about the event

1. How do you spread awareness amongst the students about the events?
2. Do you stay as the point of contact to answer any queries about the upcoming event?

-Communication

2. How do you communicate with your teammates/fellow ambassadors/organizers?
