When this is changed to a country, the next line will appear, as most location information depends on what country one is in. We do want to make sure that people have actually *selected* something, here, and aren't in the middle of moving through choices. Remember to support keyboard and not just mouse.

If they do not select a country, and stay with none, move to time zone.

Thank you for telling us you are in [Venezuela](#)!

Based on this, we expect that you are in the [Venezuelan Standard Time \(VET\) - UTC-4](#) time zone.

Note: the default privacy setting shows your state, country, and time zone.

What is your street or Post office address?

What city are you in?

What is your post code?

What state are you in?

Anything we can guess, we should guess. But let people adjust anything, since we aren't using it as a mailing address, and maybe the info we have access to isn't right.

If the country isn't enough to guess time zone, ask that as well.

If they give us a city and state, fill in the post code. Or if they give a post code, fill in city and state.

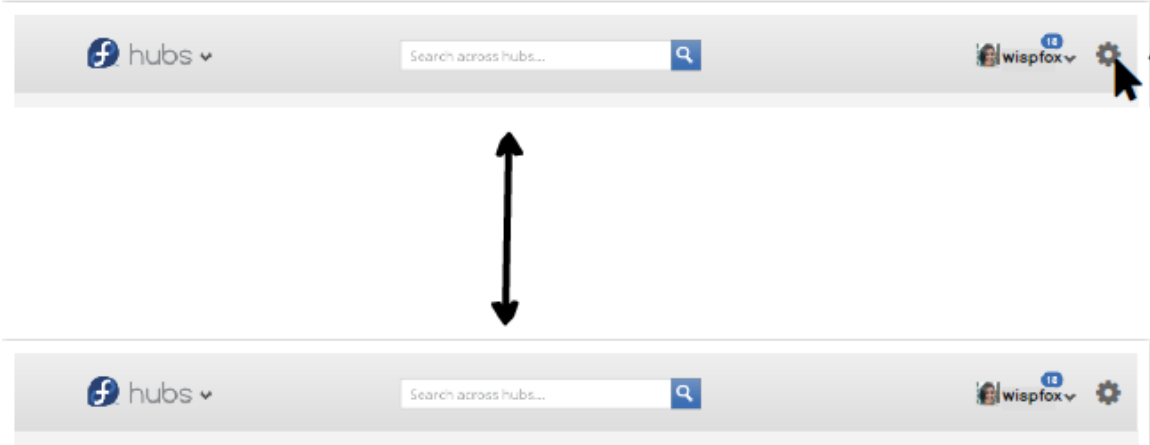

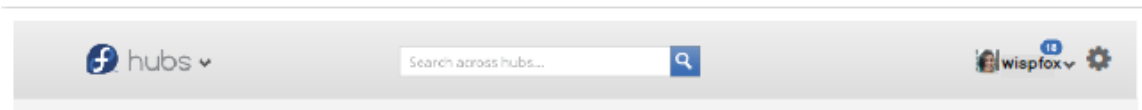
